Reader Question: Keep Dermabond Coding Simple

Question: Can I report G0168 anytime Dermabond is used in a simple laceration repair? What about if staples are also required to perform the repair?

Answer: Don't make coding the use of Dermabond for simple laceration repairs complicated. Remember these five rules for using G0168 (Wound closure utilizing tissue adhesive[s] only) to represent a laceration closure complete with Dermabond only:

- 1. HCPCS code G0168 can be reported for Medicare patients only.
- 2. For non-Medicare carriers, the CPT code equivalent to code G0168 is 12011* (Simple repair of superficial wounds of face, ears, eyelids, nose, lips and/or mucous membranes; 2.5 cm or less).
- 3. Code G0168 can be used for Dermabond-only laceration repairs in both the inpatient and outpatient settings.
- 4. If sutures or staples are used with Dermabond to perform a laceration repair, you can only bill the layered laceration repair code based on the length and site of the wound.
- 5. Code G0168 should not be reported for the use of tissue adhesives for a simple laceration repair.
