## **Quick Key: Lash Out With These ICD-9 Codes**

Regardless of how you code epilation, you must document an ICD-9 code that signals to Medicare that the procedure was performed out of medical necessity. Acceptable diagnosis codes will vary among carriers, but some ICD-9 codes that typically support medical necessity include:

- 1. 374.01 -- Senile entropion
- 2. 374.04 -- Cicatricial entropion
- 3. 374.05 -- Trichiasis without entropion
- 4. 374.54 -- Hypertrichosis of eyelid
- 5. 374.89 -- Other disorders of eyelid.
