Be ahead of the curve for FY 2018 with insight into over 6,000 new, revised, and deleted codes.

If you check the 2018 ICD-10-PCS page on the CMS.gov website, you'll find files that contain what you need to do for FY 2018, meaning they are valid from Oct. 1, 2017 through Sept. 30, 2018.
