Know the Potential Hardship Exemptions

If your practice is set to face an e-prescribing penalty but fits into one of the following six categories, you should log onto the internet as soon as possible to apply for one of CMS's e-prescribing payment adjustment hardship exemptions before the Nov. 1 deadline:

- 1. Rural Area With Lack of Access to the Internet
- 2. Limited Access to Pharmacies That Accepted Electronic Prescribing
- 3. Registration in the Medicare or Medicaid EHR Incentive Programs With Intended Adoption of Certified EHR Technology
- 4. Prescribing Medications That Legally Cannot Be Electronically Transmitted
- 5. Limited Prescribing Activity
- 6. Insufficient Opportunities to Report the E-prescribing Measure Due to Limitations in the Measure's Denominator
