The New Revenue Reality: High-Deductible Health Plans (HDHPs)

230%: Percentage increase in average annual out-of-pocket costs per patient from 2006-2015

40%: Percentage of privately insured people under 65 enrolled in HDHPs.

29%: Percentage of employees enrolled in employer-sponsored HDHPs in 2016, up from 4% in 2006.

33%: Percentage of companies that offer only HDHPs to employees

\$774: Cost increase of average deductible for people with employer-sponsored coverage between 2006 (\$303) and 2015 (\$1077).

\$4,300: Amount average American household spent on out-of-pocket co-payments and deductibles for health care

26% ... of Americans report they had trouble paying their medical bills in 2015.

42% ... of Americans say they spend all or most of their savings on medical bills.

20% ... of Americans say they don't get a good value for their health care.

20% ... of Americans say paying for prescription drugs is a struggle.

About 25% ... of a medical practice's revenue comes from self-pay today.

About 50% ... of a medical practice's revenue will come from self-pay within the next five years, experts predict.
