## **Education: Smooth Out Your FFE Transition With These 6 Sites**

CMS, NAHC, and others offer free guidance for cash- and time-strapped agencies.

You don't have to figure out the face to face encounter requirement alone. The new April 1 deadline will be here before you know it, so lean on these free resources to help you come into compliance before your time is up:

- 1. The **Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services** has issued a new MLN Matters article reviewing the requirement at www.cms.gov/MLNMattersArticles/downloads/SE1038.pdf.
