Hospice News: Heroic Hospice Nurse Recognized By Local Press

Case in point: In Michigan, a **Hospice of the EUP** nurse is being hailed as an "angel in snowshoes" for strapping on the footwear to visit a hospice patient in need of a visit, reports news station 9&10 News in Traverse City. Nurse **Nancy Miller** snowshoed about a half-mile in blizzard conditions when the bad weather prevented the regularly scheduled hospice nurse from making her visit via car.

The hospice, run by the **Chippewa County Health Department**, would have sent a snowmobile out with a nurse if Miller hadn't been able to walk to the patient's home, Miller told the news station.
