Hospice News: Hospices Plan Inpatient Facilities

Hospice facilities continue to open across the nation.

In Ohio: Aultman Alliance Community Hospital is readying its **Alliance Compassionate Care Center** hospice facility on the hospital campus, reports The Canton Repository newspaper. The facility has four beds.

In Louisiana: Hospice of Acadiana plans to break ground on its 10-bed inpatient hospice house this summer, the Daily Advertiser newspaper reports. The nonprofit expects to see about 650 patients per year in the **Calcutta House by Hospice of Acadiana**. Fundraising for the project is ongoing.

In Colorado: Nonprofit hospice provider **Pathways** plans to build a 12-patient inpatient hospice facility on its Ft. Collins, Colorado, campus, it says in a release. Inpatient care will transition over from the hospice's current space at **McKee Medical Center** in Loveland. Pathways is raising \$8 million to fund the project, it says.
