Your longer-stay patients' records will need to prove eligibility in a number of ways, but one hard and fast requirement will be objective measurements. - Palliative Performance Scale (PPS)
- Functional Assessment Staging (FAST)
- Activities of Daily Living
- New York Heart Association Classification (NYHA)
- Nutritional status measurement tools
- Weight scales
- Body Mass Index (BMI)
- Mid Arm Circumference (MAC)
- Cognition measurement tools
- Mini-Mental Exam.
