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| My life began on a sunny November morning when after a long labor in the hospital ( <b>Dx 1:</b> ), I was born a healthy baby ( <b>Dx 2:</b> ). I had 10 fingers and 10 toes, and my parents thought I was beautiful, even though I had a rather large birthmark ( <b>Dx 3:</b> ) on the left side of my face. |
| I was a good baby, although my nocturia ( <b>Dx 4:</b> ) caused my parents some sleep deprivation ( <b>Dx 5:</b> ).  |
| I had an uneventful childhood, suffering from the usual maladies of chicken pox, measles, and mumps ( <b>Dx 6, 7, &amp; 8:</b> ). Too bad vaccines for these diseases hadn't been invented yet I could have used them! ( <b>Dx 9:</b> ).   |

| Dx 2: V30.00 (Single liveborn; born in hospital; delivered without mention of cesarean delivery)   |
| <b>Dx 3:</b> 757.32 (Birthmarks)   |
| <b>Dx 4:</b> 788.43 (Nocturia)   |
| Dx 5: V69.4 (Sleep deprivation)  |
| <b>Dx 6, 7, &amp; 8:</b> 052.9 (Chickenpox NOS), 055.9 (Measles without mention of complication) and 072.9 (Mumps without mention of complication).  |
| <b>Dx 9:</b> V04.x (Need for prophylactic vaccination and inoculation against certain viral diseases)  |
| <b>Dx 10:</b> E884.9 (Fall from tree)  |
| <b>Dx 11:</b> V54.12 (Aftercare for healing traumatic fracture of lower arm)   |
| Dx 12: V62.4 (Social maladjustment)  |
| <b>Dx 13:</b> V50.3 (Ear piercing)   |
