Coding Late Effects in Home Health. Wed. July 13, 1 p.m. ET. Late effect conditions, by definition, are common diagnoses in home care. They represent the residual effect (condition produced) after the acute phase of the illness or injury has terminated. Specific sequencing guidelines accompany these late effect codes and using them correctly may determine case mix eligibility. Join Tricia A.
