You Be The Coder ... Osteomyelitis Coding Question

Question: Your new admission is a 69-year-old man with osteomyelitis from a staph aureus infection in his left lower leg, who is receiving IV antibiotics daily for the next six weeks. He has a PICC line inserted and skilled nursing is ordered to change the dressing every three days and observe for side effects from the antibiotics. How would you code this?

Answer: There has been no surgery yet and the patient isn't a diabetic, so **Laresa Boyle**, director of coding services at Longview, TX-based **Healthcarefirst** suggests coding as follows:

M0230

730.26 (Unspecified osteomyelitis, lower leg)

M0240

041.11 (Bacterial infection, staphylococcus aureus)

V58.62 (Long term (current) use of antibiotics)

V58.81 (Fitting and adjustment of vascular catheter NEC) (the PICC line).
