Some drugs are covered by Part D and Part B.

Drug Formularies Under Part D

What is covered?

- Prescription drugs only
- FDA-approved
- Medically approved indication
- Insulin
 - Supplies required for administration
- Biologicals

Note: Some 600 drugs can be covered by Part D or Part B. Part B is always the primary coverage in such cases.

Formulary Exclusions

- OTC Drugs
- Barbiturates
- Benzodiazepines
- Cough--cold remedies
- Products for weight management
- Vitamins
 - Prenatal exception
- Injectables
- Infusion products
- Drugs & Biologicals paid by Medicare A and B
