Clip 'N Save: Time For A Time Out? 5 Warning Signs That A Resident's Abuse May Be Driving A Caregiver Over The Edge

Teach staff to use this quick checklist to assess whether a resident is "getting to them" - and if so, to ask for help in coping and/or learning new behavioral management skills (or an assignment change).

- 1. Are you taking longer to answer the call light or not answering it at all (asking someone else to do it) or neglecting the resident?
- 2. Do you dread coming to work because of a particular resident?
- 3. Do you feel irritation or anger just at the sound of a resident's voice?
- 4. Do you finding yourself speaking to the person in a terse, irritated or angry tone of voice?
- 5. Are you taking the problem home with you where you think about various things the person said and becoming upset all over again?
