## **Quality Reporting: Don't Inflate Your Pain Quality Measures**

Take credit where credit's due on the MDS.

If a resident's pain management regimen controls his pain, give your facility a good grade on the MDS.

Record a zero for no pain at J2a (frequency of pain) when residents report they have been pain free during the sevenday lookback thanks to their pain management regimen.

Coding what you think the patient's pain would be without treatment will artificially increase pain quality measures - and that may give surveyors the idea the facility isn't addressing this vital clinical issue.

**Tip:** Even though a resident doesn't have enough discomfort to trigger the pain QM, make sure the facility is meeting his goals for pain relief.
