

Long-Term Care Survey Alert

Tool: Make Screening For Pain As Easy As ABCDE

Empower your residents to participate in defining goals.

The **Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services** (CMS) recently released this tool to help manage nursing home residents' end-of-life care needs.

To put it to use, keep this ABCDE mnemonic in mind:

- **A. Ask** the patient about (and screen for) pain and other symptoms on admission and periodically thereafter. Assess regularly and systematically for symptoms and their impact on the patient.
- **B.** Believe the patient's report of pain or other symptoms, what precipitates it or makes it worse, and what relieves it.
- **C. Choose** symptom control options that are appropriate for the patient.
- **D. Deliver** interventions in a timely, logical, and coordinated manner.
- **E. Empower** the patient to participate in defining the goals of treatment and planning interventions to the extent possible. Evaluate the effectiveness of chosen interventions.
