This quick 8-point checklist can keep your programming on the mark.

Activities should meet the following key criteria, suggests **Reta Underwood,** an activities specialist and president of Consultants for Long Term Care Inc. in Buckner, Ky.

- 1. The activity has a purpose and is meaningful for the resident;
- 2. The activity offers a reasonable chance for success;
- 3. The activity does not add anxiety or reinforce inadequacy;
- 4. The activity is individualized for one;
- 5. The activity is satisfying and enjoyable;
- 6. The activity significantly reduces unplanned hours;
- 7. The activity capitalizes on existing abilities; and,
