Enforcement News: Public Gets More Time to Comment on Interoperability Rules

Do you need more time to peruse the interoperability rules that the **Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)** and the **HHS Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC)** released in February? Then you're in for a treat.

Extension: HHS decided to extend the deadline to June 3, 2019, giving the public more time to weigh in. "This extension responds to requests from a variety of stakeholders, including healthcare provider organizations and industry representatives," says an HHS release.
