In Other News: Author of Obamacare Admits He Never Read His Own Bill

It's as crazy as it gets. When the healthcare bill that was signed into law by **President Obama** was being debated, a number of federal representatives and senators not only admitted that they hadn't read the text but also boasted of this fact. As House Speaker **Nancy Pelosi** had (D-Calif.) said, "we have to pass the bill so that you can find out what is in it."

But unfortunately even this wasn't the case with **Max Baucus** (D-Mont.), lead sponsor of the Senate bill that later became law.
